Student search behaviour: Google vs. the Library

did not examine their topics to identify keywords and related terms

performed simple keyword or phrase queries

did not reformulate or refine their search queries

did not move beyond the first page of results

did not examine metadata to improve searches

frequently visited commercial sites such as Amazon; content farms such as About.com; and subscription databases such as JSTOR.

Subject searches

Bring together synonyms, variant spellings, etc.

Consistent & reliable use of language

Retrieves all entries on subject regardless of language used by author

Works for any subject (Religion, English, etc.)

Word of caution



Library of Congress Subject Headings are Anglo-American standards

LCSH started in 1909

Different LCSH standards at different times

Uses US spelling

Generally adopted by UK libraries once moved to online catalogues (1970s/80s)

Generally not used on the continent

Beware of generic v specific subjects entries

Your topic may not exist (yet)

Only works for books & cover journal articles you find in e.g. SOLO

Libraries may not (yet) have full catalogue records for recently received books – or even for

older stock

Abstract

Drawing upon detailed research of inheritance practices in early nineteenth-century Stockport, this article examines how married men attempted to provide for their families after their death. It is argued that inheritance acted as an informal family welfare mechanism through which specific gender relations associated with middle-class households were reproduced. The evidence presented suggests that married male testators often used inheritance to try and 'fix' their wives into widowhood. Widows were frequently required to act as custodians of family property and maintain the domestic order. Access to property was carefully controlled and various legal devices were used to give authority to the process and ensure that the estate was used by widows to care and provide for children in certain, carefully stipulated ways. In making these claims, this article argues that recent revisionist studies that have attempted to highlight the proprietorial autonomy of middle-class women in industrializing communities ignore the forces at work which constrained the free use of property by women at certain stages in the life course. The findings of the study are also used to highlight the ways in which middle-class men's uses of property were materially and ideologically 'constrained'.


