B. NEW EXAMINING METHODS AND PROCEDURES

- A. All papers were examined by three-hour timed written in-person exams in Examination Schools. Classification procedures were the same as in 2019, pre-pandemic.
- C. Candidates were informed directly by email in April and May 2023 detailing the examination methods and procedures.

Part II - CONDUCT AND OUTCOME OF THE EXAMINATION

A. GENERAL COMMENTS ON THE EXAMINATION

Marks withheld because of the boycott prevented the full classification of 38 candidates. The marks were received after the boycott ended; the Board classified the candidates and the results were released to them on 8 November 2023.

59 students sat the examination. 21 were classified in the First Class and 37 in the Upper Second. 1 candidate's results were Incomplete.

MCE Applications – 18 MCE notices were received and were considered by the Board.

B. EQUALITY AND DIVERSITY ISSUES AND BREAKDOWN OF RESULTS BY GENDER

There is a significant and worrying gender gap in the proportion of candidates obtaining First class classifications, which it is recommended the course committee considers, alongside comparison data from the History main school, History joint schools, and PPE.
